St. Charles Community College wins \$1.1M grant for training

St. Charles Community College in Cottleville has won a \$1.1 million state grant to train workers in the growing fields of surveying; technology and sustainability; and business development.

Using the state funds from the Training for Tomorrow program, the college plans to develop specialized training modules, certificate programs and other training options in each of these areas to meet the needs of local businesses.

Training for Tomorrow grants are designed to educate Missourians for careers in growing industries and help community colleges create or expand training programs to serve additional students, Gov. Jay Nixon's office said Friday.

Over the past two months, Missouri community colleges have worked with local businesses to identify work force needs and submit applications for funding to the **Missouri Department of Economic Development**.
